

From the Railway Station to The Castle Inn, on foot

The map below shows the shortest way to walk from the station to the pub.

As you can see it's almost in a straight line, about 2.8 km, just over 30 minutes.

The first part (Hills Road, Regent Street, St Andrew's Street) is buzzing with traffic and not the most interesting part of Cambridge.

When you follow the route through Sidney Street, mostly a shopping area, you will miss most of the historic colleges (King's, St John's, Trinity)



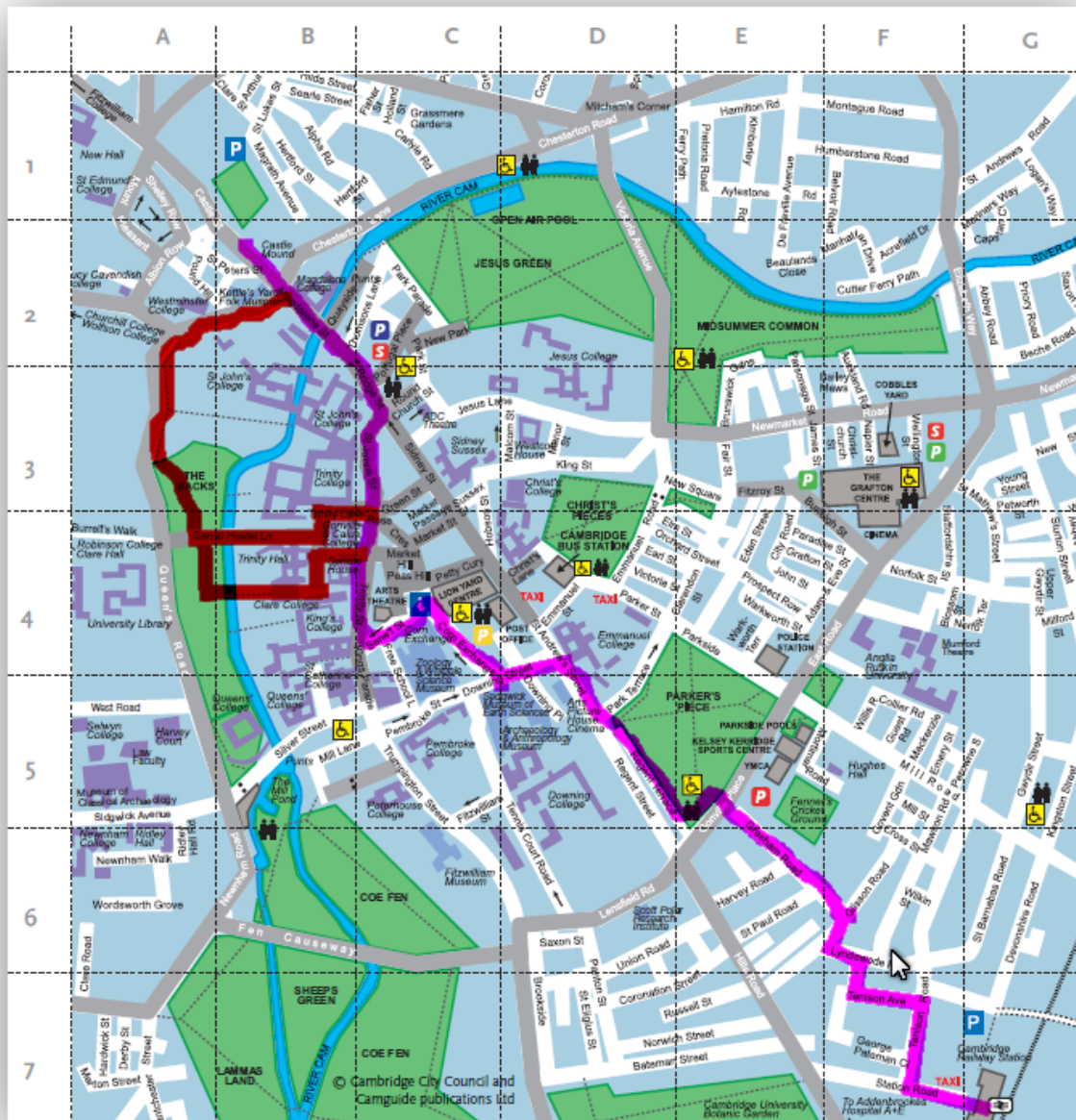

If you prefer an altogether quieter route that also leads you along the famous colleges, you can take the **PINK** route on the map below. It will take you perhaps an extra 15 minutes or so.

If you want to catch a glimpse of the river Cam and its punters, go just beyond King's College to the left at the earliest opportunity (a narrow street opposite the church, with the Senate House to your left). At the end, go left, then right through Clare College.

Alternatively you can walk through Trinity Lane / Garret Hostel Ln (off Trinity Street) which will also take you to the river and The Backs.
